DEVELOPING FUTURE RESIDENT CAMP EXECUTIVES

DESCRIPTION

This course is intended to help **emerging YMCA leaders** grow in their youth development careers through resident camping programs. In this course, participants will identify the **key competencies** needed to be successful as an executive director in a YMCA resident camp and will determine their own **professional development** opportunities as they gain insight into the role and responsibilities of camp leadership.

After exploring key leadership competencies, participants will be prompted to complete a development plan, identify a mentor and begin an experience-based assignment, and summarize the progress of their development.

This course is a 6-week commitment and is one step in a future camp executive director's career development journey. It is made up of one 12 hour classroom based work, with some on-line pre-assignments and an experienced-based project after the class.

- **FEES:** Total cost \$180. Includes meals, one night accommodations and the fee for the class.
- **TIMES:** Arrive late morning of Sunday 27th, and check in at the Welcome Center. The class will begin promptly at 1pm.
- **CREDITS:** 12 credits
